

Senate Advisory Committee on Privilege and Tenure
End-of-Year Report
2017-18

The Senate Advisory Committee on Privilege and Tenure (SACPT) met three times during the 2017-18 academic year: March 7, May 23, and June 8.

The March 7 meeting was called by President Capilouto requesting SACPT's approval for the suspension of a faculty member in a sexual harassment case, to ensure the safety and wellbeing of coworkers. The committee unanimously approved the suspension.

The May 23 and June 8 meetings regarded termination proceedings undertaken by Provost Blackwell, as described in GR X.B.1.f.2. This case is ongoing.
