Vincent and Jones called the meeting to order at 10 a.m., and welcomed the committee to its first meeting. Jones provided informational background on the charge to the committee, framed as it surveying and recommending on:

What kinds of educational activities (courses/programs/credentials) are occurring inside and outside of colleges, that are not tracked by a Senate course prefix or a Senate-approved credential, and what governance structures for them are warranted?

Jones presented (ppt, attached with these minutes) a review of some information about the University's current academic governance structure, and some examples of various kinds of non-credit bearing activities, including credentials, that are occurring inside and outside of colleges. The committee discussed how it might proceed with its charge. The consensus was that the committee first determine operational definitions, within the scope of its charge, for 'educational activities,' 'course,' 'program' and 'credential.' We will the first week into December to decide those definitions. The committee will then go into an 'information collecting phase' that will probably wrap over into early January. Based on what that collected information shows, the committee will develop pertinent recommendations, with the target of providing those recommendations to Senate Council some time in February.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.

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
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RCR *In-Person* Training Sessions Now Being Offered


