Vincent and Jones called the meeting to order at 10 a.m., and welcomed the committee to its first meeting. Jones provided informational background on the charge to the committee, framed as it surveying and recommending on:

What kinds of educational activities (courses/programs/credentials) are occurring inside and outside of colleges, that are not tracked by a Senate course prefix or a Senate-approved credential, and what governance structures for them are warranted?

Jones presented (ppt, attached with these minutes) a review of some information about the University's current academic governance structure, and some examples of various kinds of non-credit bearing activities, including credentials, that are occurring inside and outside of colleges. The committee discussed how it might proceed with its charge. The consensus was that the committee first determine operational definitions, within the scope of its charge, for 'educational activities,' 'course,' 'program' and 'credential.' We will the first week into December to decide those definitions. The committee will then go into an 'information collecting phase' that will probably wrap over into early January. Based on what that collected information shows, the committee will develop pertinent recommendations, with the target of providing those recommendations to Senate Council some time in February.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.

“This rule also **applies to** new or existing **courses** that bear the imprimatur of UK as an educational institution, are taught by UK faculty, and **are offered to the public**.”

“This rule applies **regardless of whether** or not the course is recorded on an academic transcript and whether or not the course is eligible toward a certificate or degree. This rule **does not apply to** individual activities of a faculty member or other UK employee in which they may use the UK logo simply to indicate their status as UK employees.” SR 3.2.3

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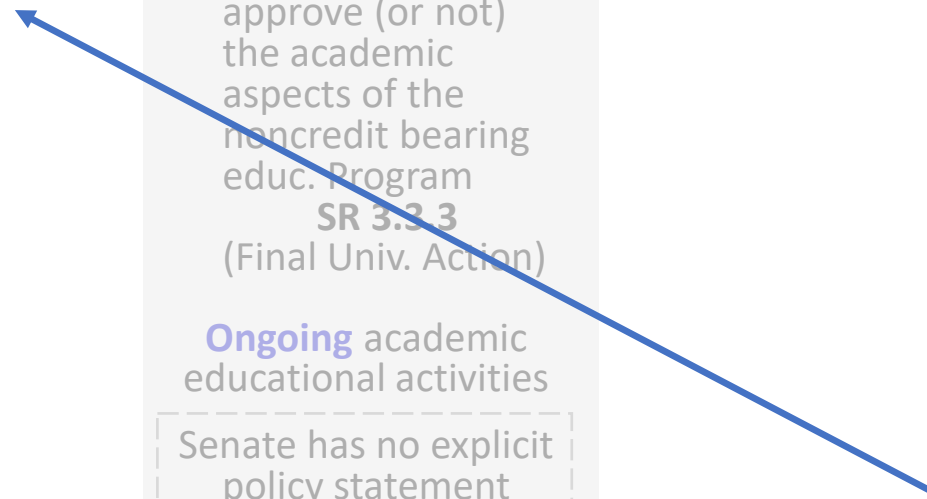
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“**If** a proposed course will not be recorded on UK transcripts and cannot be used toward a Senate-approved certificate or degree, **then final approval** of the course is conducted pursuant to the **Rules of the College** of the originating educational unit and does not require approval above the level of the College. The College Rules may further delegate responsibility to department or program faculties (GR VII.E.1-6). **If** the originating educational unit is not administratively housed in a college, **then** the department chair or director shall forward the proposal to the appropriate **Academic Council**, pursuant to SR 3.2.3.3.3.1 below. Elementary Education Teacher Education Program Online Portfolio Directions

1. Submit all TEP applications materials to TEB 166 during the acceptance window. (Scan or take clear photos of your letters of recommendation before you turn in the packet.)
2. After the window closes, you will be added to a Canvas non-credit course called “Elementary TEP applications”. Accept membership.
3. Once in the course, you will need to upload the following documents:
 - a. Electronic copy of your transcript
 - b. Short paper which includes a brief autobiography and why you want to be a teacher
 - i. Tell a little about yourself, your background, experiences and rationale for choosing this career.
 - ii. No more than 2 typed pages double-spaced.
 - c. A document describing your community service activities which total or exceed 30 hours
 - i. You must have at least 30 clock hours of community service.
 - ii. Include a brief statement describing how these have informed your perspective on what teachers need to know in meeting diverse needs in today’s classroom.
 - iii. No more than 3 typed pages.
 - d. A summary of your experiences with elementary-age children



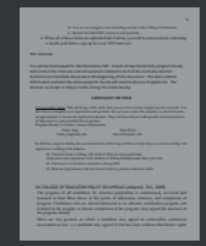
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
