A-H 655 New Course Proposal Rationale

This course provides a 600-level graduate number for a research writing skills seminar that has previously been taken by some entering graduate students at a 500 level, together with senior art history majors. The 655 allows us to provide the skills course to graduate students who may decide later in their program to pursue the thesis track and to offer it at a higher level for graduate students only as demand requires.

A-H 655 Clarification of Rationale for New Course

The new course will be offered at the more advanced level expected of graduate students who have some research writing experience and it allows us to offer the course to those students only. It will allow more sophisticated application of method and historiography than undergraduates can encompass. It allows us to separate graduate training from the undergraduate capstone experience and devote A-H 555 to undergraduate needs only.
