Good afternoon! The purpose of this email is to explain some course changes that you may already be aware of, and to inform you of the possible need to submit a program change to change the requirements for your particular degree.

CHE 105 has changed from 3 credit hours to 4 credit hours.

CHE 231 has changed from 2 credits to 1 credit.

CHE 233 has changed from 2 credits to 1 credit.

There are a number of degree programs (listed below) that require some combination of CHE 105, CHE 231 and CHE 233.

The changes to these courses may result in a change to the number of credit hours for some degrees. Due to the number of programs that may be affected and the need to make such changes quickly, Chair Swanson has approved the process outlined below. (In short, the need for a form and the need for review by the UC is being waived.)

- 1. The DUS for each program that will incur a change in credit hours due to the CHE changes must follow normal college procedures to change the program.
- 2. Upon receipt of necessary college approval(s), the dean's office or DUS will send an email to me, Sheila Brothers (sbrothers@uky.edu) with the following information:
 - a. Degree name and major.
 - b. Home academic department and college.
 - c. The current number of credits for the program, and the proposed number of credits for the program.
 - d. Date of internal college (department, council, etc.) approvals.
- 3. Upon receipt of the emails, they will be placed on a web transmittal for 10 days, for approval due to lack of objection.

If your program does NOT need to be changed, please let me know. All memos must be received by April 25.

PLEASE NOTE: If a program wishes to change any other course requirements or electives than the CHE courses listed above, the normal program change process must be followed.
