8. Rationale for Change(s): (If rationale involves accreditation requirements, please include specific references to those.)

Changes are recommended in order to target coursework highly relevant to secondary English language arts preservice teachers (secondary English education majors), as distinguished from courses relevant to standard English majors who do not plan to teach. Course recommendations proposed here, including recommended courses in the University Studies Program, are especially reflective of the need for preservice teacher candidates to study, learn, and understand issues of cultural and social diversity in the 21st century. Further recommendations for preservice English teachers include more strategically aligned coursework in content areas such individuals are expected to teach as future professionals, including applied coursework in writing, theater, communications, journalism, and fine arts/humanities.

In the course of developing these recommendations, the chair of English education has met and consulted with department chairs and undergraduate program directors in art, communications, journalism/telecommunications, and theater to ensure that these departments are willing and able to offer courses to SEED majors. In all cases, these representatives have responded enthusiastically and agreed with the recommended revisions set forth here. Additionally, area high school department chairs were consulted for input regarding perceived needs of new high school language arts teachers. Finally, the secondary English education program faculty voted unanimously to propose these revisions.
