The purpose of the changes is to provide greater flexibility of choice in the upper division electives, reduce the need for petitions for exceptions, and to facilitate time to graduation.

The 500-level language elective (an additional course beyond the four-year Russian language sequence) is often difficult to obtain without accelerated study abroad or overlapping with the 400-level language courses. It is proposed now as an option, but not a requirement.

The non-RUS electives listed are now not regularly offered due to changes in staffing in the other departments, or are often taught with a content unrelated to the RUST major. They remain options when the content is appropriate, but not a specific requirement. The change of designation from "Major Department" to "Major Program" reflects the fact that the major is now housed in MCLLC and suitable electives might well be found within the department's other non-RUS offerings. We do not want to exclude this option. (The elimination of the word "Area" in the name of the major is an editorial correction, since the name of the major everywhere else is just "Russian Studies.")
