14. Rationale for Change(s) – if rationale involves accreditation requirements, please include specific references to that.

Previous to the BASW curriculum revision beginning in Fall 2011, MA 109 and MA 111 were listed as courses that fulfilled the USP (General Education) math requirement for pre-social work major students. Following the USP revision and implementation of UK Core, the BASW pre-major and major course requirements were revised. Based on the information available at the time, faculty voted to eliminate the MA 111 course and list MA 109 only as a pre-requisite for the major. However, MA 109 is currently designated by the math department as the pre-requisite for MA 123 and is not listed as a course that fulfills the Quantitative Foundation of UK Core. MA 111 is a pre-requisite for MA 109.

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Students either need to test into MA 109 or take MA 111 as a pre-requisite. The information below is available for students about MA 109 on the UK Core website:

“Note that MA 109 is NOT approved as a Quantitative Foundations course. Students in a major requiring calculus will use calculus course (MA 113, 123, or 137) while students not requiring calculus should take MA 111, PHI 120, or another quantitative foundations course.”

The BASW does not require calculus and, upon additional review, the faculty voted to return faculty have revisited the curriculum and have voted to return to the math requirements that were previously acceptable for social work majors under the USP program—MA 109 or MA 111—as either were considered to be adequate for students’ preparation for and success as majors in the BASW program.
