# 14. Rationale for Change(s) – if rationale involves accreditation requirements, please include specific references to that.

The 2009/2010 external review of the anthropology department recommended streamlining the undergraduate major. The changes stated above streamline the requirements for gaining a BA in anthropology and bring our requirements closer to the requirements of anthropology departments at peer institutions.

With regard to question 13i, our current program (as well as the changes we are proposing) do not have specific credit hour requirements broken into the categories of 300 and 400-500. Rather, the relevant category for the changes to our program is "300 and above". Specifically, we seek to require 18 hours of anthropology class at the 300 level or above.

Of the total 39 hours required to complete the major, 24 hours must be at the 300 level or above.
