GEN 100, Issues in Agriculture and Natural Resources, has been required by most majors in the College of Agriculture as an introductory course focusing on social, political, economic, and scientific issues arising from agriculture and related disciplines. A substantial focus of the course was on developing skills in oral and written communication, using the issues as the "fodder" for such communications. Thus, the course was partially (or fully) satisfying the communications requirement of the University Studies Program. The College of Agriculture saw tremendous value in the course, and retained it as a requirement even when the USP communications requirement was suspended. When the new General Education proposal came along, requirements for Composition and Communications I & II were deemed impossible for GEN 100 to meet, thus the faculty team reviewing the role of GEN 100 in the College of Agriculture strongly recommended that this course be re-developed as a US Citizenship offering for College of Agriculture students. Please note that we intend to require the course of all first-year students along with any transfers who have not yet satisfied their US Citizenship requirement.
