| 14.   | What has prompted this change?  The course is part of the core Latin Institute (i.e., Active Latin) curriculum, which means oral proficiency and composition in Latin are distinctive features of this course, differentiating it from our other 600-level seminars. The previous course description did not make this sufficiently clear. Since we propose deleting overly detailed descriptions of chronological scope in the title of CLA 611, we remove the word "late" in the title of 612, to correspond to the proposed title for CLA 611. Lastly, since we will be renumbering and redefining our Latin composition courses, we are changing the prerequisite so that it doesn't refer to a specific course number, since there will now be two composition courses, either of which will satisfy the requirement, under a different set of numbers. We also wanted to allow for the situation which could arise that a Latin Institute student might come to us fully prepared for the 600-level courses without going through our own composition sequence. |   |                        |  |            |  |  |  |
