Thank you for your email regarding the proposed program change(s) to **Communication**, **Bachelor's (09.0101)**.

My email will serve 2 purposes: 1.) Next steps for SACSCOC, and 2.) Verification and notification that you have contacted OSPIE—a Senate requirement for proposal approval.

- 1. Next steps for SACSCOC: None required
- 2. **Verification that OSPIE has reviewed the proposal:** Based on the proposal documentation presented and Substantive Change Checklist, the proposed program changes (refer to list below) are not substantive changes as defined by the University or SACSCOC, the university's regional accreditor. Therefore, no additional information is required by the Office of Strategic Planning & Institutional Effectiveness at this time. The proposed program change(s) may move forward in accordance with college and university-level approval processes.

<u>Description of Proposed Change(s):</u>

Currently, our GCCR requirements are listed as: COM 252 Introduction to Interpersonal Communication and COM 351 Introduction to Communication Theory 6 OR COM 252 Introduction to Interpersonal Communication and COM 326 Communication Strategies for Professional Excellence....... 6 We would like to remove COM 252 as a GCCR requirement. COM 252 is required as a pre-major course, and we would like to keep COM 252 as part of pre-major requirements. We propose retaining COM 326 or COM 351 as our majors' only GCCR requirement (3 credit hours total). This will not result in a decrease in overall total number of credits required for the program given that we want to maintain COM 252 as a required pre-major course, but not as part of the GCCR. Our reasoning is two-fold: First, COM 252 has no pre-requisites or other enrollment restrictions therefore many students outside of our major enroll in COM 252, including COM minors. It is not practical to uphold GCCR standards in a course that serves many non-COM majors. Second, COM pre-majors could conceivably take COM 252 before they have attained sophomore status, an additional GCCR stipulation. In contrast, COM 326 and COM 351 are restricted to COM majors and have pre-requisites that help ensure students are completing the GCCR course at an appropriate point in their progression.
