Dear Danielle,

on behalf of the Undergraduate Council, I am reviewing your EE499 course drop request.

Just a few questions:

(1) What is the rationale for this change from one course to two courses?

The rationale was stated in the EE 490/491 proposal that was submitted and passed in 2009. The rationale stated on that paperwork was: The change for the Senior Design course to two semesters will allow sufficient exposure to a wide range of topics such as team management, time management, budget management, and writing and presentation skills. An ABET review of our curriculum indicated that many of our senior designs lacked evidence of critical engineering processes such as setting specifications and designing around them. The two-semester Capstone Design proposal will remedy the lack of these processes. The curriculum will have 3 hours less in Technical Elective requirements in order to accommodate the additional 3 hours in senior design.

(2) You did not indicate whether dropping this course will change requirements for any program (item 6), will it?

The Computer Engineering (COE) program required students to take CS 499 or EE 499, but a program change has been submitted to give COE students the option to take CS 499 and one Technical Elective OR EE 490 and EE 491. I'm not sure where this program change paperwork is as of the date of this email.

(3) Does having two courses (which ones are the new ones, by the way?) (EE 490 and EE 491) instead of one will change credit hours for students or have any other program implications? This should be explained in questions (1) and (2) above. Dropping EE 499 will not affect the credit hours for the EE program, because one Technical Elective was

removed. It will also not affect the credit hours required for the COE program with the two options stated in question (2).
