B. any two 200-level ENG introductory courses, plus any two ENG courses at the 300+ level;

or

C. any one 200-level ENG introductory course, plus any three ENG courses at the 300+ level;

or

D. any four ENG courses at the 300+ level.

Rationale for Proposal: These changes will: 1) open up our Minor to a wider array of students by giving credit for our 100- and 200-level courses, thus encouraging students in other disciplines to pursue an ENG Minor; 2) move our Minor more in line with the Major by incorporating our central skills course, ENG 330 "Text and Context"; and 3) make the course choices easier by reducing the Historical Survey requirement to a single course, eliminating the antiquated Shakespeare requirement, and allowing total flexibility in the choice of 300+ level courses.

English — Minor

The minor consists of a total of 18 hours, of which at least 9 hours must be at or above the 300 level. The hours are to be distributed as follows:

- any ENG Historical Survey course 3 hours
 - ENG 330 Text and Context 3 hours
 - four more ENG courses, with a maximum of one 100-level course and a minimum of two 300+ level courses. Combinations may include:
 - one 100-level ENG UK Core course (e.g. ENG 107, ENG 171, ENG 191) plus one 200-level ENG introductory course (e.g. ENG 230, ENG 280, ENG 290) or any ENG 300+ level course, plus any two ENG courses at the 300+ level, **or**
 - any two 200-level ENG introductory courses, plus any two ENG courses at the 300+ level; **or**
 - any one 200-level ENG introductory course, plus any three ENG courses at the 300+ level; **or**
 - any four ENG courses at the 300+ level 12 hours
