The first change about the balance between 300 and 400 level ECO elective courses is motivated by the fact that the department has proposed 5 new ECO elective courses at the 300 level and we are renumbering 4 of our 400 level courses back to the 300 level. This is intended to give our students a wider array of options, but

we want to be sure that majors take at least 6 hours of their electives at the 400 level. Our second change, to drop the Gatton College elective is motivated by change in AACSB rules. There was a requirement about the number of hours Gatton students had to take outside and inside of the college that has been removed and so this specific requirement is no longer necessary and we prefer to remove it to give our majors more flexibility in choosing elective courses.
