According to page 60 in the UK Graduate Bulletin, the Specialist in Education (EdS) requires "a minimum of 30 credit hours of graduate work beyond the master's degree, of which at least 15 must be in courses numbered 600 or above. A departmental committee is responsible for helping students plan individual programs. The program should contribute to specialization in a field but should not neglect the broader development of the individual. The student must complete an independent research project (equal to three but not to exceed 6 credit hours) and submit a written report, a copy of which is to be filed with the department directing the research."

The current Specialist in Education (EdS) dgree in Educational Leadership Studies "requires 33 credits of formal coursework" (p. 168) and enrollment in "EDL 785 Independent Work in School Administration for at least 3 credit hours or for a maximum of 6 credit hours" (p. 169). In other words, a total of 36-39 credit hours of courseswork, which is 3 credits less than the 42 credit hours required for the Doctorate in Education (EdD) program. According to the UK Graduate Bulletin (p. 74), the EdS in Educational Leadership Studies is the only program that (a) is thesis based and (b) requires more than 30 credit hours.

A recent review of student files was conducted. Among the 61 who enrolled as EdS-seeking students in the principal certification program and completed the required 33 credits of coursework for certification, only 3 completed a thesis and were awarded the EdS. Among the remaining 58 students, 7 changed program designation to MEd (awarded degree), 4 changed program to CERT (non-degree), and 45 have not progressed toward degree completion--even those participating actively in a "EdS support group" facilitated by the DGS. Most of these 45 individuals assumed leadership positions in schools or districtis and simply do not have time to complete a formal thesis.

EDL is under an EPSB mandate to redesign its principal certification program at a post-master's level. EDL will use the EdS as the post-master's degree in which certification and Rank 1 are accomplished. This would resolve the issue of non-completion rates in the future EdS program.
