

University of Kentucky Faculty Trustee Election Nomination Petition – 2014

1. Use this petition form to nominate an eligible person

Persons eligible for election as Faculty Trustee are:

Regular, full-time University Faculty members in the Regular Title Series, Special Title Series, Extension Title Series or Librarian Title Series, at or above the rank of Assistant Professor who have not been appointed to an administrative position at or above the level of department chair and who are not on phased retirement. A list of persons eligible to be elected is [posted](#) at the University Senate web site for this election.

Status of Relatives of Eligible Persons:

According to state law, “No relative of a board of trustee member shall be employed by the university” (KRS 164.225). The UK Board of Trustees has interpreted this law to include “parents and children, husbands and wives, brothers and sisters, brothers- and sisters-in-law, mothers- and fathers-in-law, uncles, aunts, nieces and nephews, sons- and daughters-in-law, and step-relatives in the same relationships. Employment includes regular and temporary full- and part-time employment, including student work-study and graduate assistant programs.” A person accepting nomination as a candidate who has a relative employed by the University is expected to disclose that relationship (Gov. Reg. X.A.2)

Petitions will not be opened and certified until after the deadline for submission of petitions.
