I volunteered for the position of faculty representative on the Board of Trustees because I know that I can be an effective voice for the concerns of all faculty. I have been a regular title series faculty member at the University of Kentucky for the last 29 years. As a tenured full professor, I have served on numerous University committees including the Faculty Council and University Senate. In addition, I was Interim Director of the Markey Cancer Center and have been a member of the KMSF Board. For the last 12 years I have been Chief of the General Surgery division which has grown to over 30 faculty.
