This is an update on the faculty trustee election.

THE CANDIDATES

The SREC certified **two eligible candidates** to run in the faculty trustee election. In alphabetical order, those candidates are:

ELECTION TIMELINE

With only two candidates, we will move directly to the final voting round (SR 1.5.2.2). Voting will run from Monday, March 27 at 8am to Monday, April 3 at noon. I will email you at the start of this voting period.

Please plan to vote. A high voter turnout is critical to empower our elected representatives to the Board. The voter turnout in last year's election (66%) was the highest in more than a dozen years and drew the immediate attention of UK's top administrators.

CAMPAIGN PERMISSIONS

You may use your <u>own</u> UK email address to email others <u>directly</u> and express your opinions about the qualifications of candidates. As per UK's general policies on IT resources (<u>AR 10:1</u>), that is among the academic freedoms afforded to everyone in our University community.

You may <u>not</u> use UK <u>group</u> communication resources to <u>advocate</u> for or against any trustee candidate. Group communication resources include UK listservs, UK social media tools like Facebook and Twitter, and time in UK institutional business meetings (e.g., department faculty meetings).

You may use UK group communication resources to <u>encourage participation</u> in the election, provided such use is not otherwise disallowed and provided you do <u>not</u> advocate for or against any particular candidate.

The candidates have a special listserv (facultytrusteeelections-l@lsv.uky.edu) that they can use to communicate with voters. They also have a list of all eligible voters (including voters' unit affiliations and email addresses) that they can use.
