These changes involve College/School Level Changes, Pre-Major Changes and Major Course Requirement Changes in Family Sciences. In January 2011, the School of Human Environmental Sciences voted to change the School-wide requirements from HES 100, HES 400 and one class outside the students' major

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prefix, which for FAM students was DHN 101--Nutrition and Food Science, to HES 100 and a new course FAM 352--Issues in Family Sciences. DHN 101 was moved to our Pre-major requirements. These school-wide requirements have been approved by the Senate.

Under Pre-Major requirements, we have dropped the two courses in BIO, CHE, PHY. These changes are a result of the changes in the UK Core requirements. The science requirement is now met in the UK Core requirement, "Natural, Physical, Mathematical" by the students choice for 3 hours. Nutrition and Food Science--DHN 101--has been added to pre-major requirements.

The Major Course Requirements that will change, include dropping FAM 252--Introduction to Family Science. FAM 352--Issues in Family Sciences, now under college/school-wide requirements, will cover that course content. In addition, we are adding FAM 357--Adolescent Development (new title and description), to the major requirements to keep the total hours for the major requirements to 27.

All these changes were approved by the FAM faculty March 2, 2012.
