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requirement for an international practicum experience will be changed to a selective as this will allow for working students the ability to complete in country. Additionally, this will significantly reduce cost for students as there are limited financial resources for that type of international travel. Changing the certificate from a large list of electives to a smaller list of selective courses allows for continuous quality assessment and improvement of the certificate. The smaller list of selectives will ensure a curriculum covering key concepts related to Global Health.
