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2. Overview of Changes

2a	Describe the rationale for the changes, including results from the most recent program review if applicable. (450 word limit)
	<p>The Human Health Sciences (HHS) program recently submitted a curriculum change proposal to formally request the addition of a new pre-professional track in athletic training (pre-AT). This change was approved by the Senate on September 29, 2017. Upon review of that proposal, there were minor mistakes/oversights regarding both the HHS core course requirements and the pre-professional track course requirements (including the pre-pharmacy, pre-physician assistant studies, and pre-physical therapy tracks). More specifically, the CNU 503 course was originally listed as HHS 503. HHS 503 does not exist and should have been listed as CNU 503. Next, the PHY 213 course requirement was included in the pre-pharmacy track instead of the pre-physical therapy track. In addition, the CHE 230/231 requirement was accidentally left off of the pre-PA studies track and therefore, added back to the track in this proposal. Also, the PGY 206 course requirement was left off of the pre-pharmacy track. Next, the BIO 208/209 course was listed as a 3-credit hour course and it should have been listed as a 5-credit hour course. Finally, the UK Core course requirement total credit hours were originally listed as 33 credit hours and should have been listed as 34 credit hours- this was a simple math error. We have simply fixed the aforementioned mistakes in this current proposal.</p> <p>Since the previous HHS proposal was approved, our HHS faculty voted to suspend the HHS 351 (Health Services Administration) course as a core course requirement for HHS students. We do not think this course is necessary for our pre-professional HHS students because it is heavily focused on health services management. However, HHS students can still take HHS 351 as an elective if they choose.</p> <p>We have also added KHP 415 as a pre-AT track requirement.</p> <p>As a result of the aforementioned changes, we have updated the credit hour totals for the HHS core requirements, pre-professional track requirements, and free electives (see Tables 1a & 1b).</p>

BIO 208/209 was originally listed as 3 credit hours and should have been listed as 5 credit hours.

Additionally, the PGY 206 requirement was left off as a requirement for the pre-Pharmacy track in our previous proposal.

Finally, CHE 230/231 was initially left off the original proposal as a requirement for the pre-PA track and should have been included so we've added it to this proposal.

These were all minor oversights on the previous HHS proposal so we've fixed them here.

We also added KHP 415 to the pre-AT track requirements.

We've updated pre-professional and free electives totals based on changes described here and above.
