Explain, if necessary: Experimental Genetics was originated in the Department of Microbiology, Immunology & Molecular Genetics as MI 604 in the 1990's. When the Integrated Biomedical Sciences (IBS) program was developed, MI 604 became part of the IBS curriculum and was cross-listed as IBS 605. The cross-listing has remained, although students rarely sign up for MI 604 since a vast majority of students sign up for IBS 605.

Why is this course being dropped?: The curriculum for Integrated Biomedical Sciences (IBS) is currently being revised, which involves a number of different changes that includes the reduction of didactic coursework and an increase in teaching in small group format. The contents of IBS 602 (Biomolecules and Molecular Biology) and IBS 605 (Experimental Genetics) are being merged into a single 3-credit hour course (New course: IBS 602, Molecular Biology and Genetics).
