Attached are proposed changes to the International Business Minor. The changes were initiated because the world regional/foreign language concentration no longer exists and students were struggling to find the surviving courses. The goal of this requirement was to provide an opportunity to gain additional cross cultural understanding. The new requirements to complete a course through education abroad, taken an additional USP cross cultural course or a year of foreign language are consistent with this objective. As such, this change simply provides multiple avenues to this end.

Students must take at least nine hours of upper division classes from the Gatton College (50 percent of the upper division requirement for a minor).		plus one of the following: a USP cross cultural course at the 200 level and above that is not used to satisfy University Studies Program requirements, at least three credit hours earned through an education abroad experience, or 6 hours of college level foreign language

Rationale for Proposal
The world regional/foreign language concentration no longer exists and the courses were not offered on a regular basis. The intent of the requirement was cultural exposure and so an additional course from the USP cross-cultural requirement, a year of foreign language or an education abroad experience would satisfy this objective.


