14. Rationale for Change(s) – if rationale involves accreditation requirements, please include specific references to that.

The proposed changes do not involve any new courses, but instead change some classes that were offered as electives and makes them required. In addition, we have eliminated several classes that were previously required and have made them electives. These changes are in line with recommendations of the National Strength and Conditioning Association and the American College of Sports Medicine which are the major governing bodies in our field. More specifically, these changes are a component of the "Education Recognition Program" which is sponsored by the National Strength and Conditioning Association for which we have recently become a member. These changes move our program away from the traditional "physical education" curriculum and into the "exercise science" curriculum which is in high demand by our students. In addition, we have included a number of new electives outside of our program which are required by various professional degree programs (medical school, physical therapy and physican assistant). Since our program already serves as a training program for advanced degrees, these changes will enhance that role. The changes to the program are to meet the needs of pre professional students for continuing furthur education in graduate programs and also better prepare students for the job market within the field.
