14. Rationale for Change(s) – if rationale involves accreditation requirements, please include specific references to that.

BIO 102: Human Ecology is currently included as a requirement within Program Related Studies. Students are also required to take PSY 100, SOC 101, BIO 103, ANA 209, and PGY 206 in this core. The course description for BIO 102 is: "A study of the interrelationships of man populations space energy food mineral resources and other life on earth. Not for life science majors." Our students are already taking a lot of hours, slowing their time to graduation, and reducing their required coursework by eliminating a class that is not completely relevant to their major would move them more quickly toward graduation. Given that BIO 102 is

not a prerequisite for other courses in Program Related Studies, the Professional Education Course Sequence, or the Major in Kinesiology or Health Promotion, this will reduce the total number of credit hours for our Kinesiology and Health Promotion Teacher Certification (double major) students from 142 to 139. Those who opt to major in Kinesiology Teacher Certification only will have a minor requiring 18-24, bringing their total credit hours from 136-142 hours down to 133-139 total credit hours.

We are proposing that KHP 152: Techniques of Swimming and KHP 252: Water Safety Leadership be dropped from a one-course option in the Performance Area Courses for the Major in Kinesiology. As a result, KHP 162: Outdoor Education through Activities would be the only option in this section. Students are also required to take KHP 147, KHP 154, KHP 156, KHP 157, KHP 210, KHP 250 and KHP 260 in the Performance Area Courses core. The rationale behind dropping KHP 152 and 252 as options within this section is because most schools (especially in Kentucky) do not have a swimming pool or access to a swimming pool; thus, preparing teacher candidates to teach this information is not relevant. Most do, however, have access to some open space or modified equipment for outdoor activities. Therefore, we would like to modify our curriculum to meet the current needs of physical education teacher candidates. This change will not affect the total credit hours required for graduation.
