Approval of Minutes for August

Minutes were approved as written from the August meeting.

Comments

Dr. Johnson has met with approx. ½ of the faculty and the meetings are going very well. He has meetings set up with the remainder of the faculty soon. He also stated that everyone can make their own judgment for the Thursday night football game on Oct. 15. The building will close at 6:00 pm. Tricia Adolph is taking long term disability. A video is being made for her.

A&P Course Proposal for HPE

The syllabus has been developed for KHP 205. A vote was made to eliminate PGY 206 and ANA 209 for TEP students, but it still needs to go through the approval process. Hopefully, this process will be completed by next fall. The change of the course title will include Health Education. Dr. Johnson stated that the syllabus includes Health & PE to cover the area.
