The minor in Linguistics requires 18 hours of course work to be selected as follows:

LIN 211 and 212 (6 hours)

Choose one phonetics/phonology course:

LIN 500 or LIN 515 (3 hours)

Choose one morphosyntact/semantic course:

LIN 512, LIN 505, LIN 509, or LIN 516 (3 hours)

Choose two other LIN courses at 300 or above (6 hours)

Proposed Total Hours: 18

Rationale for Proposal: The proposed change better aligns the minor with the requirement changes recently made for the major. Students will now have to take a 'sound' aspect of linguistics, either phonetics/phonology (B2 list above) and a grammatical/semantic aspect (B1 list above). In this way they are required to have (a) two introductory courses and (b) at least two core courses.
