The Master's with initial certification program had an original requirement of 9 credit hours of EDU645 which included faculty participation from Curriculum & Instruction, Special Education & Coun., Educational Psychology & School Counseling, Educational Policy & Evaluation, and Educational Leadership Studies. However, that wide participation of faculty in one 9 credit hour course made tracking individual faculty load and evaluation of faculty in multiple sections from the many departments very cumbersome. Therefore, the four foundations departments created one credit courses for each department. The change involves reducing the 9 credit hours of EDU645 to 3 credit hours from Curriculum & Instruction to accommodate these four 1 credit hour foundations classes. That also requires increasing the minimum credit hours in the program from 33 credit hours to 32-34 credit hours, depending of choice of foundation courses. This change is the collaboration of the 5 departments that have participating faculty in the program. The content of the program remains unchanged. The change also allows students to substitute some full 3 credit courses in electives for 1 credit hour required courses in the same content areas.

I have trying to track down the problem with the MA Advanced Secondary Education submission. Ms. Ellis lists two courses as holding up approval of the program changes. One is ELS691 Legal Perspectives for Teachers. That was approved by the COE on 1/26/10. That course is marked "approved by the Senate Council."
