Program Description:

Master of Arts in Education or Master of Science in Education Secondary Education (grades 9–12) (Advanced Certification)

For a Master of Arts in Education, a minimum of 30 credit hours are required including 18 credit hours of professional education and 12 credit hours outside the College of Education related to the student's content teaching certificate area. Consult the Director of Graduate Studies for specific recommendations within this broad framework. The program gualifies teachers for a Rank II teaching certificate. Students completing subject area course work in mathematics or science are eligible for the Master of Science in Education degree. Consult the Director of Graduate Studies for more detailed information regarding this program.

Admission Requirements

In addition to the admission requirements set by the Graduate School, departmental requirements for admission include initial teacher certification in secondary education and a departmental application process including three letters of professional reference.
