	The Martin School proposes to remove the course PA 624, Government Information Systems, from the requirements for the MPA degree. This two credit hour course, once required for accreditation purposes, concerns information technology and information systems in the not for profit and government sectors. The course provides essential information for students to administer large data sets. Recently, the NASPAA accreditation standards were modified and no longer require this course as part of the core curriculum. Furthermore, the fundamental concepts of information management are already covered in other core courses. Issues concerning privacy or data protection are covered in ethics -PA681. Use of data is now adequately covered in statistics PA621 and other courses. Thus, PA 624 is redundant and obsolete to the MPA degree. This change acknowledges advances in data management through the internet and cloud databases. The MPA continues to require an appropriate forty hours of credit, and this reduction will permit some reorganization of the curriculum sequencing with practical benefit to students.
