The CSD curriculum was last revised in 2004. During the past 14 years, the scope of practice and standards for accreditation have changed. Additionally our exit survey data and national data suggest that employment settings have changed along the need of improvements in professional skills such as understanding of evidence based practice, the importance of cultural sensitivity and need for a strong awareness about ethics. As such, we are submitting changes to the requirements of the Master of Science in CSD degree that include both new courses and minor course changes. Below is the rationale for these changes along with relevant links

- 1) Comply with new standards adopted by our professional organization's accrediting body effective August 1 2017, (reference available here: https://caa.asha.org/wp-content/uploads/Accreditation-Standards-Documentation-Guidance.pdf). Key curriculum changes included revisions to standards about professionalism, interdisciplinary and collaborative teamwork, clinical reasoning, diversity, cultural competence and evidence based practice.
- 2) Respond to exit student surveys from 2014-2016 where students consistently asked for a) increased coursework in swallowing and b) offer more flexibility with electives for graduate students
- 3) Respond to changes in practice trends as reported by our professional organization the American Speech Language and Hearing Association (ASHA see link for an example report here http://www.asha.org/uploadedFiles/2015-SLP-Health-Care-Survey-Private-Practice-Trends.pdf
- 4) Respond to alumni and employer surveys that we have received input that we have received.

For the graduate program, there will be a total of 10 graduate courses affected that reflect 6 courses with credit deductions, 1 course description change, and 2 new courses to add more opportunity for 1) addressing professional issues related to our discipline as required by the standard change and 2) adding more coursework to address increased knowledge about dysphagia which meets a workplace trend. This means that there will be a net change of ONE (1) additional credit for graduation to earn the MSCSD degree.

An important distinction here when reviewing this program is that to receive ONLY the M.S. degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders, students will now need to complete a minimum of 34 semester hours of didactic coursework. To receive the M.S. degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders AND also fulfill the American-Speech-Language-Hearing Association certification requirements, students will be required to successfully complete a minimum of 34 semester hours of didactic coursework PLUS a minimum of 30 credit hours focused on: clinical experiences (minimum 21) and two credits of an elective course, clinical practicum (minimum 4), and three credits of clinical orientation. Actual hours worked at a clinical site is dependent on the site schedule.

DATE: June 15, 2018

The faculty of the Division of Communication Sciences and Disorders (CSD) requests approval for both **graduate** and **undergraduate program changes** as well as **undergraduate and graduate course changes**. Students graduating from the master's program are eligible for employment as a speech language pathologist. The bachelor's program is a preprofessional program for speech language pathology, audiology or other related field. Because of the complementary and coordinated nature of the undergraduate and graduate programs, the proposed changes are being submitted concurrently.

General Background

The CSD curriculum (for both UG and Graduate programs) was last revised in 2004. During the past 14 years, the scope of practice and standards for accreditation have changed. Additionally our exit survey data and national data suggest that employment settings have changed that require new skill sets. In addition there is a need for improvements in professional skills such as understanding of evidence based practice, the importance of cultural sensitivity and need for a strong awareness about ethics. As such, we are submitting changes to the requirements of the Master of Science in CSD degree that include both new courses and minor course changes. We believe such changes will better reflect current practice trends and responses from our alumni and student survey information. The detailed rationale for this request is provided with supporting tables and figures that will assist in understanding the proposed changes to the CSD curriculum.

Briefly, the proposed changes in graduate degree requirement and the curriculum are to 1) comply with new standards adopted by our professional organization's accrediting body, Council on Academic Accreditation (CAA), 2) respond to exit student surveys from 2014-2016, 3) respond to changes in practice trends and 4) respond to student, alumni and employer input that we have received.

Rationale for Course and Program Curricular Changes for the GRADUATE Program

- 1) Comply with new standards adopted by our professional organization's accrediting body effective August 1 2017, (reference available here: https://caa.asha.org/wp-content/uploads/Accreditation-Standards-Documentation-Guidance.pdf). Key curriculum changes included revisions to standards about professionalism, interdisciplinary and collaborative teamwork, clinical reasoning, diversity, cultural competence and evidence based practice. As such we have incorporated those topic areas into new coursework called Professional Issues (CSD 720)
- 2) Respond to exit student surveys from 2014-2016 where students consistently asked for a) increased coursework in swallowing, and b) more flexibility with electives for graduate students.
- 3) Respond to changes in practice trends as reported by our professional organization the American Speech Language and Hearing Association (ASHA see link for an example report here http://www.asha.org/uploadedFiles/2015-SLP-Health-Care-Survey-Private-Practice-Trends.pdf.

Current Course Requirements and Proposed Course Requirements

For the graduate program, there will be a total of six courses that require minor course changes (credit changes, course description and course title. Two new courses are requested so that we can offer additional training in dysphagia and also address the needed changes in relation to ethics, professionalism, cultural competence and evidence based practice as reflected in new standards described by our accrediting body. The total required course credit change will increase from 33 didactic course credits in the current curriculum to 34 didactic course credits in the proposed curriculum.

An important distinction here is that to receive *ONLY* the M.S. degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders, students will need to complete a minimum of 34 semester hours of didactic coursework. To receive the M.S. degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders *AND* also fulfill the American-Speech-Language-Hearing Association certification requirements, students will be required to successfully complete a minimum of 34 semester hours of didactic coursework PLUS a minimum of 21 semester hours focused on clinical experiences and electives. The current and proposed course requirements for the MS graduate degree in CSD are shown below.

Implementation

Graduate Program: Each year approximately 30-34 graduate students are enrolled in the Master of Science in the CSD program. We plan to enroll our last cohort of master's students under the present curriculum in Summer of 2018 and this cohort will graduate in Spring 2020 (See Timeline below). Assuming that we receive approval for this proposal by the end of the AY 18/19, we plan to enroll our first cohort of master's students under the new curriculum in Summer 2019 and this cohort will graduate in Spring 2021. The original plan was that in the AY 2019/20 we would be offering the current curriculum to our 2nd year graduate students and the new curriculum to our newly admitted 1st year graduate

students. Then beginning in AY 2020/2021, both 1st and 2nd year graduate students would be following the new curriculum proposed in this document. The unit postponed and admitted its first cohort under the new curriculum in summer 2020 and the second cohort under the new curriculum in summer 2021. See Figure 2 for a schematic representation of this implementation plan for the graduate courses. Table 2 illustrates the sequence in which students may take the CSD proposed graduate curriculum.

Degree Name

We are not requesting a program or degree name change. We wish for the master's degree to remain a "Master of Science in Communication Sciences and Disorders" (MSCSD) from the Division of Communication Sciences and Disorders within the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences house in the College of Health Sciences.

Course Prefix and Numbering System

We are not requesting a modification in the course prefix or our courses, but wish to retain the prefix of CSD. Currently our Master's courses use 600 and 700 level courses. Additionally, any course that allows enrollment of both UG and Graduate students is indicated as a 500 level course.
