	<p>The only change being requested is to remove SW 733 Community-Informed Organizational Interventions as a required course in the CSD (Community and Social Development) concentration. The rationale for this change is that the SW 733 course does not flow or fit well with the rest of the CSD concentration and relies heavily on a very specific method of community assessment and intervention. The course was developed by a faculty member who is no longer with the College. The course content fell within that faculty member's area of expertise and some of the content was based on the research of that instructor. Much of the course content overlaps with the SW 701 Community Assessment course and the SW 731 Advanced Policy course. The current instructors in the CSD concentration curriculum have identified the course as not fitting well with the other required courses and requiring expertise in an approach that few social workers utilize in practice. Dropping the course as a required course would allow for a third elective for CSD concentration students.</p>
