RE: **AGENDA ITEM:** University Senate Meeting, Monday, November 8, 3:00 p.m. in the W.T. Young Library Auditorium. Proposed Changes in College of Dentistry Calendar, second-year

Background: At the request of the Faculty Council of the College of Dentistry, and upon approval by the Senate Council, a change in the academic calendar of the College of Dentistry is proposed.

Proposed: Second-year dental students are currently scheduled to end their academic year for Fall 1999-Spring 2000 on July 21, 2000. Based on a miscalculation of weeks within the 1999-2000 academic year, the second-year dental students are scheduled to meet for 48 weeks when, according to the College bylaws, they should meet for 47 weeks. In order to adhere to the College's bylaws, a new ending date for second-year dental students is proposed: July 14, 2000.
