Recommendation from Senate Council Regarding Changes to Fall Break **ACTION ITEM**

At the Senate Council meeting on April 16, the SC voted to send to the Senate a motion recommending approval of a one-day Fall Break, to occur the day prior to Thanksgiving Day.

Therefore, there would no longer be an academic holiday on the first Friday in October. Instead, the Fall Break academic holiday would be on the Wednesday immediately prior to Thanksgiving Day.

Motion from Senate Council: Positively recommend to the Senate that the current one-day (Friday) fall break be changed to occur on the Wednesday immediately before the Thanksgiving holiday.

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Senate approve changing the Fall Break date from the first Friday in October to the day immediately before Thanksgiving Day.
