Motion #2 from Library Committee to Senate Council:

The University Senate Library Committee notes that the libraries are unique in that they serve the entire University of Kentucky community. The committee also believes that the challenges faced by the libraries are poorly perceived by their constituents, including the faculty of the University of Kentucky. The committee members believe that the libraries must be an integral part of the University's achieving "top 20" status, and that it is imperative that the faculty be familiarized more fully concerning the challenges faced in the library's achieving that distinction. Accordingly, the Library Committee forwards the following motion to the University Senate Council:

"The Dean of Libraries shall be invited to appear annually before the University Senate to provide a 'State of the Library' report."
