Our purpose today is solely to provide you with information about one of Senate Council's Activities on behalf of the University Senate.

- 1. Earlier this year University Senate Council was invited to develop improved methods of evaluating presidential performance.
 - A. As a result of dissatisfaction with both the metrics and use of faculty input from previous surveys.
- 2. An *ad hoc* committee consisting of Greg Wasilkowski and myself was formed to start this process.
- 3. We have developed a template of questions for a survey to perform this evaluation.
 - A. A powerpoint about the committee's proposed format can be found on the Senate Council website.
- 4. We invite your participation in this process and ask you to look at the proposed format so that you can provide other questions as well as assist in designing an effective survey mechanism.
- 5. The value of this survey will be to provide formative advice to University presidents about the concerns of their faculty.
 - A. More importantly, it is an opportunity for the faculty to provide the Board of Trustees with the kinds of questions we think they should be asking the University President when evaluating their performance in the future.
