Drops requirements for 102, 250, 340, 420, but adds 497.

Pre-major requirements have been added so that students have knowledge of the components of Community and Leadership Development before becoming majors. A minimum grade of C is required for the 10 hours of pre-major classes so that students show some proficiency in the major's emphasis areas. The pre-major courses are also intended for enrollment management for the upper level CLD courses. The proposed curriculum also allows more flexibility for students to study the various emphasis areas as best fits their academic interests; the two separate current options (agricultural communications and public service and leadership) will no longer exist. The flexibility will also help the department manage faculty teaching resources since more courses taught by more different faculty will be available for students outside the core course requirements.
