



The University Assembly

Regulation

The University Assembly shall consist of all faculty members of the University, including emeritus faculty, all staff employees, including retired staff employees, and all students. It shall meet in special session on the call of the President or the University Senate. The President or the President's authorized representative shall preside. The Secretary of the University Senate shall be Secretary of the Assembly and shall be responsible for adequate notice of meetings, including a statement of subject or subjects to be discussed.

The Assembly may express its views on any matter affecting the University to the University Senate, Staff Senate, Student Government Association, and the President or, through the President, to the Board of Trustees.

The executive councils of the University Senate, Student Government Association, and the Staff Senate shall jointly comprise a University Assembly Executive Council. The President, or the executive council of the University Senate, Student Government Association, or Staff Senate, may call a meeting of the University Assembly Executive Council. At least one meeting of the University Assembly Executive Council shall occur annually. The President or the President's authorized representative shall preside. The University Assembly Executive Council may exercise the responsibility of the University Assembly on behalf of the University Assembly. The President, and the Chairs of the executive councils of the University Senate, Student Government Association, and the Staff Senate, shall meet at least once each semester to share views and promote solutions to issues and opportunities of the University.
