Academic Ombud's Report to the Senate

Thank you Professor Hippisley, Senators and guests.

It is my pleasure to present the Academic Ombud Report for the 2013—2014 Academic Year. I would like to first thank Laura Anschel for the concise statistical report, which will be included in the senate minutes for your future reference.

During the 2013-2014 academic year, the Academic Ombud Services Office handled 497 issues including non-academic offense issues, academic offense issues, and appeals sent to the University Appeals Board (2012/13 (N=537); 2011/12 (N=529); 2010/11 (N=506); 2009/10 (N=482)). The number of cases involving academic offenses decreased this year to 132 (compared with 191, 177, and 139 for the three previous years). Ten of the academic offenses were 2nd offenses and one was a 3rd offense leaving 121 first offenses. Of the total number of academic offense cases (132), 109 students (83%) had no contact with the Ombud, 11 students contacted the Ombud but decided not to appeal, and 8 students (under 10%) charged with an academic offense appealed their academic offense charge. One case involved cheating and the other seven were for charges of plagiarism. The academic appeal for cheating was denied. Of the seven students who appealed charges of plagiarism, two appealed the offense charge (1 upheld; 1 denied), and five students appealed the severity of the offense (4 upheld; 1 denied).
