

Senate's Retroactive Withdrawal Appeals Committee (SRWAC)

YEAR END REPORT 2013-2014

Appeals Submitted: 81
Appeals Approved: 68
Appeals Denied: 11
Appeals Tabled: 2

Basis of appeals requests and generalized rationale:

Medical	40 – Broad range – e.g. depression, bipolar, surgery, drug reaction, etc.
Financial	7 – Parent accident, ran out of funds
Personal	6 – Grief, could not adjust to being away from home
Legal	0 – Divorce, criminal
Family	9 – Parent divorce/death, grandparent death
Military	0 – Called up
Partial	5 – Learning disability, thought had withdrawn from all classes
No Documentation	3 – Unable to provide document, not registered with DRC

Note: The basis for requests and rationale do not equal totals above as many requests were for multiple semesters but the same reason was presented for all.

Waiver:

Approved	9
Denied	1 – No documentation
