Proposal for a University Scholars Program for the Master of Arts in Art History and Visual Studies (AHVS)
Introduction/Rationale

The School of Art and Visual Studies (SAVS) in the College of Fine Arts offers the Bachelor of Arts in Art History with 3 concentration options: Art History; Museum/Curatorial Studies; and Visual Studies. We offer the Master of Arts in Art History and Visual Studies with a minimum of 30 hours of course work for a thesis option (plan A) and 36 for the non-thesis option (Plan B). The terminal degree for Art History and Visual Studies is a PhD.

The School proposes to establish a University Scholars program for our MA program in AHVS in order to:

- Nurture our best undergrads who may not yet be ready or competitive for admission to top graduate programs, but have potential to excel with additional MA level work
- Better prepare students for curatorial and museum careers thus improving job placement & long-term professional success
- Shorten time to degree by one year for students wishing to pursue an MA in AHVS
- Make better use of available scholarship resources by targeting the best undergraduate students in our program for support
- Strengthen AHVS major; improve recruitment into & retention within the major
- Use the new 5 year combined program to establish distinct identity for the UK AHVS program nationally
- Improve quality of graduate students within AHVS MA program

Program Structure

A student seeking admission to the MA University Scholars program in Art History and Visual Studies is required to meet the following requirements:

1. The applicant must have 90 hours completed or in progress towards the BA degree at the time of application, including at least 18 credit hours in AHVS. The applicant must be on track to complete their undergraduate degree within one semester of their admission into the University Scholars Program in AHVS. Students who fail to complete their undergraduate degree within that time frame will be disqualified from participation in University Scholars program; they will be eligible to apply for admission to AHVS MA as regular graduate students.

3. The applicant must have an overall GPA of 3.2 or above on a scale of 4.0 and must have a grade-point average of 3.5 in AHVS (including cross-listed) courses.

4. The applicant must follow the current application procedures for the Graduate School and the Graduate Program in SAVS and must meet the admission standards of the Graduate School and Master's program Art History.

5. A-H 555, if not already completed, must be completed in the first year of the University Scholars program

Program of Study

This program does not change any undergraduate or graduate degree requirement. Students admitted to the program will be able to pursue either Track A or Track B options. Assessment of graduate and undergraduate programs remains unchanged.

After their admission to the University Scholars program, students may take up to twelve hours at 500 that will count towards both the Bachelor's and Master's degree requirements.

Students who are admitted to the University Scholars program will be able to follow the course of study available to our graduate students.

The Graduate Advisor will advise the students in the University Scholars Program on the graduate program. The student's undergraduate advisor will continue to provide advice on the student's undergraduate program.

Proposed plan of study

Spring semester after admission into University Scholars program:

up to 4 grad level courses (500 level), at least 2 in AHVS - minimum credits: 9-12 cr
1st MA year (full time enrollment)

Fall - 3-4 graduate level courses:	9-12 cr
Spring - 3-4 graduate level courses + thesis/exam prep	9-12 cr

Total:	30-36 cr


