9	<u>Library:</u> Recommends policies to promote educational interests of University as a whole with respect to the Libraries. (See <i>Senate Rules 1.4.2.4</i>)
10	Research: Responsible for reviewing research policies and implementation. (See Senate Rules 1.4.2.5)
11	Retroactive Withdrawals: Decides all student requests for retroactive withdrawals. (See Senate Rules 1.4.3.2)
12	<u>Rules and Elections</u> : Codifies and interprets the <i>Rules</i> of the University Senate. Also initiates changes. Certifies eligibility in elections. (See <i>Senate Rules 1.4.2.1</i>)
