Hi Roxie:

No need for 769; that is being phased out and universally replaced with 767 (I believe Davy Jones is involved in getting 767 included in the Senate Rules). 768 would only be needed if the program mandated residence credit for Plan A (thesis) students; in some programs the requirement is 24 hours of coursework plus 6 hours of 768, for others the thesis simply substitutes for the additional 6 hours.

- A. 748 Master's Thesis Research. May be repeated three calendar years (0 credits [US 3/6/00]
- B. 749 Dissertation Research. May be repeated three calendar years (0 credits) [US 3/6/00]
 767 Dissertation Residency Credit (2) NOT in Senate Regs
- C. 768 Residence credit for master's degree. May be repeated once. (1-6 credits equivalence)
- G. 770-779 Seminar courses.
- H. 769 Residence credit for doctoral degree. May be repeated indefinitely. (0-12 credits equivalence)
- 790-799 Research courses.
