


Hi Janie,

I have a question about EDC 731. It is offered in Summer I 2014 as TBD for the entire 4 weeks and an intense one-week session was also put in the system-6/2-6/6, 9:00-3:00 in room 355 DH. KT emailed me that we can't do it that way but we often have classes that are listed as TBD and have a special period of time listed rather than just keep it as TBD. I don't understand why we can't do this, since it follows the senate rule that a course has to either start at the beginning of the semester or end on the last day of the semester. This class does it...it runs the entire 4-weeks of intersession. She left the dates but took out the times and room. Is this because we had the times listed for the professional development portion of the course?

She forwarded this to me when I asked her about it:

The following courses need to have their start or end date adjusted, or please provide appropriate senate approval that allows them to be taught as accelerated courses.

Please confirm the start and end date of the term. The first meeting date of the course needs to take place with the first 7 days from the start date of the term, or the last meeting date needs to take place during the last week of the term. If the course does not meet either of these criteria points, please provide or seek Senate approval.

For Senate approval, please send an email to Shelia Brothers explaining why the course should be taught within dates other than what has been defined below and forward the approval to our office for proof.

Approved start and end dates are defined below.

- Six-week courses that begin at the beginning of the 4-week term; and
- Six-week courses that end at the end of the 8-week session; and
- Any course schedule that falls strictly within the 4-week term, as long as the duration does not exceed 4 weeks and it either starts or ends on the same date as the 4-week term starts or ends; and
- Any course schedule that falls strictly within the 8-week session, as long as the duration does not exceed 8 weeks and it either starts or ends on the same date as the 8-week session starts or ends.
