PROPOSAL FOR PH.D PROGRAM CHANGE PhD in Music Music Education Option

The current PhD in Music has been in existence for over thirty years. The option in Music Education must be updated to match new knowledge in the field, such as in the areas of scientific research methodology, use of technology, understanding of human behavior, musical cognition, and higher education. This proposal requests approval for an updated curriculum at the PhD level for music education studies. The proposed change affects only the Music Education Option; the other two options, Music Theory and Musicology/Ethnomusicology, remain unchanged.

This proposal is a result of collaboration among the music education faculty, with input from recent PhD graduates, and guided by a national study titled "Doctoral Programs in Music education: A Continued Examination of Degrees, Curricula and Qualifying Examinations", by Joanne Rutkowski, Peter Webster, and Jason Gossett (2012). In addition, we examined the offerings of several universities with the reputation of having good PhD programs. We lean heavily on the examples from the Florida State University and Penn State University because of the success of their graduates in the field music education. Finally, we are mindful that our proposed PhD meets the UK Graduate School requirements as well as satisfying the mandates by National Association for School of Music (NASM).
