When benchmarking other N.A.S.T. accredited B.A. degree programs, we found that required credit hours varied from a low 30 credit hour program (University of Iowa) to a high 65 credit hour program (LSU), but the majority of B.A, degrees averaged between 40 and 45 credit hours. This reduction in credit hours will be beneficial to our students in that it will allow them ample opportunity to complete a minor or even the flexibility to double major in an interdisciplinary area of interest.

This reduction in credit hours will be beneficial to our students in that it will allow them ample opportunity to complete a minor or even the flexibility to double major in an interdisciplinary area of interest.
