Three changes are proposed.

- 1. The first change is to the degree title. Currently we award a Masters in Rehabilitation Counseling (MRC) degree. We are proposing that our degree title be changed to Master of Arts in Counseling.
- 2. The second change is to the major. The major is currently "Rehabilitation Counseling". The proposed major will be Counselor Education.

Rationale for change 1 & 2: We are pursuing continued accreditation in rehabilitation counseling and accreditation in clinical mental health counseling. According to our accrediting body (Council on Accreditation of Counseling and Related Programs, i.e. CACREP), the degree name of Masters in Rehabilitation Counseling (even with a Specialty in Clinical Mental Health) will not be allowed for accreditation in Clinical Mental Health Counseling. If we retain that degree name, we can only be accredited as a Rehabilitation Counseling program. Accreditation guidelines require that the degree title reflect the accreditation given. According to Ms. Jamie Pak, Assistant Director of Accreditation, "If your program sought separate accreditation in Rehabilitation Counseling and in Clinical Mental Health Counseling, the title of "Master's in Rehabilitation Counseling with a Specialization/Concentration in Clinical Mental Health Counseling" is problematic due to the MRC degree. There could be significant challenges for a Clinical Mental Health Counseling student graduating with a MRC degree."

3. The third change is to the specialties. We are proposing that one of the specialties be changed from "Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling" to "Rehabilitation Counseling." The word "Clinical" is to be deleted. The other specialty remains "Clinical Mental Health Counseling."

Rationale for change 3: One of our current specialties is clinical rehabilitation counseling. Our accrediting body now has two separate accreditations for rehabilitation counseling: the first is rehabilitation counseling and the second is clinical rehabilitation counseling. Our current accreditation is in rehabilitation counseling, not CLINICAL rehabilitation counseling. Therefore, we need to drop the word "clinical" from the specialty area of "clinical rehabilitation counseling" making this simply a specialty in "rehabilitation counseling."

Please note: none of the SLOs, program coursework, requirements, etc. are changing at this time. We are simply updating the name to reflect the standards in the field.

My email will serve 2 purposes: 1.) Next steps for SACSCOC, and 2.) Verification and notification that you have contacted OSPIE—a Senate requirement for proposal approval.

- 1. **Next steps for SACSCOC:** None required
- 2. Verification that OSPIE has reviewed the proposal: Based on the proposal documentation presented and Substantive Change Checklist, the proposed program changes (refer to list below) are not substantive changes as defined by the University or SACSCOC, the university's regional accreditor. Therefore, no additional information is required by the Office of Strategic Planning & Institutional Effectiveness at this time. The proposed program change(s) may move forward in accordance with college and university-level approval processes.

### <u>Description of Proposed Change(s):</u>

· Two changes are proposed. 1. The first change is to one of the specialty names for our degree. Currently we award a Masters in Rehabilitation Counseling (MRC) degree. We offer two specialties: 1) clinical rehabilitation counseling and 2) clinical mental health counseling. Our accrediting body now has two separate accreditations for rehabilitation counseling: the first is rehabilitation counseling and the second is clinical rehabilitation counseling.
