Name: Ad hoc Senate Technology Committee

Charge:

- Review the structure of and relationship between existing technology committees (defined in AR 10:2 – <http://www.uky.edu/regs/files/ar/ar10-2.pdf>) and senate committees and propose changes to:
 - ensure effective faculty and student input;
 - streamline processes;
 - reduce redundancy.
- Review technology proposals that affect faculty and students and endorse or propose changes to them.
- Provide a channel for communication between faculty/students and campus IT and administrative units about technology proposals and technology infrastructures.

Membership:

- We recommend six members, to include representatives of the standing committees defined in AR 10:2 (<http://www.uky.edu/regs/files/ar/ar10-2.pdf>) and standing Senate committees identified as critical conversation partners in this ad hoc committee's charge as well as members drawn from the faculty and student bodies.
