Proposed Suspension of MS: Clinical Research Design

This is a recommendation that the University Senate approve the suspension of admission into an existing graduate program: Clinical Research Design in the Department of Preventative Medicine & Environmental Health within the College of Public Health.

Rationale:

This program has has perpetually low enrollment. There are 3 students currently in the program. Two are slated to graduate this spring and 1 the following year. If the suspension is approved, students will be notified that they have 5 years to complete the program before it is potentially closed. College of Public Health did an analysis of programs and courses. In their analysis they found there was sufficient overlap between what they offered and the College of Medicine offered. A majority of CPH students are in the residency program for the MPH and so do not use the MS. This MS was really for MDs and they can still get virtually the same degree in the College of Medicine. There are no resources (faculty or courses) lost with the closing of this certificate.


